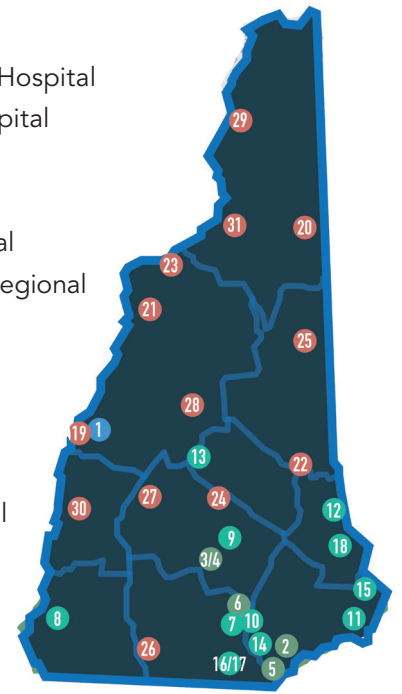

Across the state, hospitals and health systems are leading efforts to create healthier communities in New Hampshire.

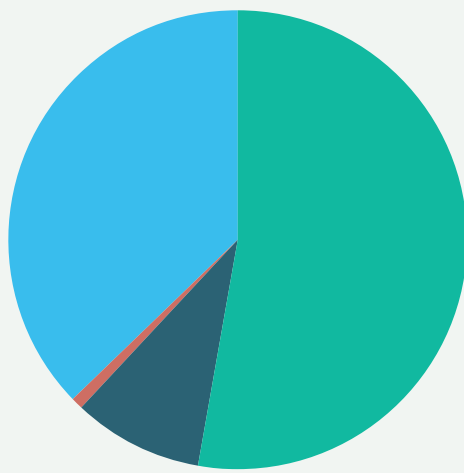
\$446.2 Million
